COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

A complaints procedure may be used by clubs concerning any persons named on the Area List and vice-versa.

1. A letter outlining the nature of the complaint is sent to the Area Representative and the JDS&E Chairman within one month of the event. The Representative/Chairman will speak to the person concerned.
2. The JDS&E will send a letter to the person concerned who replies by letter.
3. The complaint will then be reviewed by the Area Committee. A discussion will be made on whether, or not, to uphold the complaint.
4. All correspondence appertaining to the matter will be strictly confidential.
5. Should three formal complaints be upheld, against the same person during a period of three years, the person concerned will have to re-take their Area Test if they wish to remain on the Area List.

National Demonstrator's Complaints Procedure:

Complaints regarding a National Demonstrator should ONLY be sent to the Chairman of the National Demonstrator's Committee within one month of the event by the Club Chairman/Vice Chairman, by letter, please include your address and e-mail address.



NAFAS CODE OF PRACTICE

THE BLUE FORM -This is helpful to both Clubs and Judges, Demonstrators, Speakers & Teachers. Please read it and use it.

PROGRAMME SECRETARIES - Should ensure that the correct details are given on the Blue Form and may like to include the following information in a covering letter:-

1. Description of venue including postcode, stairs/lift etc.
2. Details of the hall/theatre, staging, stage lighting, sound system.
3. A good map of the route and area of the venue.

CHAIRMAN- Should ensure that: A demonstrator is made welcome, with adequate able-bodied help to unload/and re-load their materials. Light refreshments are provided. Toilet facilities are provided. All invited guests are seen safely to their car.

DEMONSTRATORS, SPEAKERS AND TEACHERS - Should arrive on time, be ready to start at the time stated. Thank the Chairman for her introduction, leave the demonstration area tidy. Thank club members for their help.

CANCELLATIONS- Further details to be found in the NAFAS Guide Lines.

Demonstrators/Clubs are obliged to fulfil engagements as per the Blue Form but may, if necessary, withdraw from the commitment without obligation, up to 6 months prior to the meeting.

If, due to unavoidable circumstances, a cancellation is necessary within the 6 months period before a demonstration the Demonstrator is expected to find a substitute of equal standing.

If the club declines the substitute, the Demonstrator has fulfilled their responsibility.

If a Club cancels a Demonstrator at short notice, any expenses incurred are the responsibility of the Club, subject to negotiation.

The Area Representative for each discipline will be pleased to help with queries.



EXTREME CONDITIONS

During periods of extreme conditions (Weather, National Crisis, Health, Warfare, Terrorism, act of God) or any other threat to stability or safety, it is recommended that lines of communication are established between the Club and the presenter, when possible, in advance of the date of booking.

Open and frank discussion should take place between the presenter and the Club Chairman/ Programme Secretary. Severity of the condition must impact upon the decision, by either party, to continue with the event. The individual's HEALTH and SAFETY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED AT ALL TIMES.

Either party (Club or presenter) may reach the decision to cancel the event in the best interest of all concerned. It is possible that Government Legislation or local restrictions imposed may necessitate cancellation. Help and advice may be sought from Social Media, Websites and Regional News, NHS, Police, Met Offices and Motoring Organisations.

Both parties should remember that severe conditions may be regionalised and conditions will probably differ greatly from area to area. Weather cancellation decisions should not be made prematurely as these can vary considerably from day to day.

Once a decision has been made then both parties should reach an understanding in the form of a gentleman's agreement. Costs may have already been incurred by the Demonstrator, as flowers need to be purchased well in advance, or they may have incurred vehicle hire costs. Should either party cancel it is recommended that the Club would reimburse any costs already incurred and the Demonstrator would waive their fee. The Club should rebook the Demonstrator at the time of cancellation when possible.

Clubs are strongly recommended to consider possible alternative entertainment for their meeting if severe weather is forecast. Contingency plans could include members doing a selection of mini demonstrations.

Clubs are reminded to take out event cancellation insurance for open or large events. Careful scrutiny of the policy is necessary to include Global Disease Pandemic situations or any other threat causing cancellation.
